*PRINCIPALS SCHOLARSHIP (70%) CRITERIA

A Level applicants who wish to apply for a 70% scholarship must meet the following criteria:

- Students must have the academic and personal potential to gain a place at Oxbridge or another elite university where interviews are compulsory (LSE, Imperial, UCL, St Andrews)
- Students must study only premium/facilitating subjects at A Level: Maths, Further Maths, Economics, Geography, History, Biology, Physics, Chemistry, English Literature, History of Art, Psychology, and Modern Languages.
- Students that wish to study non-facilitating subjects at A Level i.e. Business, Accounting will not be considered
- Students can intend to apply for any degree at university
